FOLLOW THESE STEPS IN PREPARATION FOR ROACHES TREATMENT

Before Aardvark comes out to treat for roaches, we ask that you remove all food items from cabinets and set someplace out of the way so that our tech is able to place roach bait in the cabinet, if necessary. However, after we do not leave the food sitting out as this could potentially become a problem.

The following is a little bit of information on roaches and their behavior. This information may help you understand why you may have them and how to help get rid of these pests.

German roaches live up to one year. They only mate once in a lifetime but are able to become pregnant any time after that continuously. The babies mature in 36 days giving a constant influx of new roaches if not stopped.

In order for the chemicals to be most effective there are some things that the tenant must do.

- Take out the trash every day.
- Pull out stove/refrigerator to sweep behind.
- Wash the dishes every day.
- Have one area that is designated as the dining area.
- All perishable food items should be placed in sealed plastic containers.
- Do not leave food sitting out.
- Wipe down cabinets/countertops. Dispose of any expired foods.
- Report all plumbing leaks no matter how small.
- Do not spray or bomb after we have treated, this causes our chemical to be ineffective.
- If you are heavy smokers, also please step outside to smoke, the nicotine in cigarettes also can break down the chemical and make less effective and the roaches more difficult to get rid of.

Doing these things will help us solve your roach problem much faster and help keep them from returning. Thank you for your cooperation and patience throughout the treatment process.
